



Sustainability field trip to the old Hanseatic city of Lüneburg in Lower Saxony, Germany

The Charles University Environment Center invites Czech students studying (any academic discipline) at the Bachelor's level at a university outside Prague to enrol on its six-day field trip to the beautiful university town of Lüneburg to study how 'sustainability' is applied in theory and in practice in the German context.

The trip is fully funded for Czech students, including **transport, accommodation and meals**; a small returnable bond, however, will be charged for all successful applicants. The only requirements are a good knowledge of English and an eagerness to learn more about sustainability. Some written work will be required of students which will be worth 2 ECTS.
