Study Area Ore Mountains


- Ore Mountains (*Erzgebirge / Krušné hory*) = **shape** of a slanted writing desk some 150 km in length, formed by tectonic forces
- **Ridge** averaging **800-1000 m** above sea level (max. 1244 m)
- **Border** between Saxony and Bohemia (Germany / Czech Republic) for many centuries
- **Acid rocks** and soils, **raw climate**
- Rich in **beautiful landscapes**, many raised bogs, mountain meadows and spruce forests
- **Traditional cultural landscape** of European significance, esp. shaped by ore mining

Concept of strategies and measures

1 – Landscape management

- **Cooperation** of authorities and organizations responsible for landscape and biotope management
- Exchange of **experiences**

2 – Regional product and marketing chains

- Long-term maintenance of valuable **mountain meadows**
- Markets for **local products**

3 – Bioenergy

- Energy recovery of biomass from landscape management measures

Concept of strategies and measures

4 – Wind energy

- Wind turbines may **disturb animals** (bats and birds), alter landscape's **visual quality** and attractiveness for tourists
- Choice of **suitable sites**, exclusion of protected and aesthetically sensitive areas (e.g. the mountain ridge)
- Intensification of **regional planning** and cross-border Environmental Impact Assessment

Concept of strategies and measures

5 – Black Grouse

- **Decline:** due to afforestation, predators, disturbances (e.g. by tourists)
- Needs: maintaining and restoring **habitats**
- resolving conflicts with **land users**

Concept of strategies and measures

6 – Tourism

- Competitive destination management **organisations** („Destinační agentura Krušné hory“ in Klíny)
- Common **marketing strategies**
- Stimulation of **bi-/multilingualism** on both sides of the border
- **Innovative offers** in the sphere of rural tourism
- Better cooperation between **nature conservation** and tourism

7 – Environmental education and visitor management

- **Education** of visitors
- Visitor management in **fragile ecosystems** (e.g. raised bogs, black grouse habitats)
- sophisticated **tourism concepts**
- Use of **new technologies** (e.g. smartphones)

8 – Winter sports

- Ecologically-compatible **ski trails** on both sides of the border
