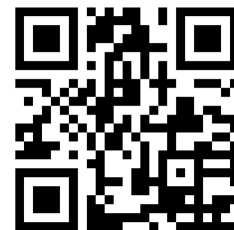

The program includes presentations by speakers from six Central European countries. Other participants are warmly invited to participate in discussions and to join an open platform for exchanging ideas.

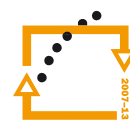

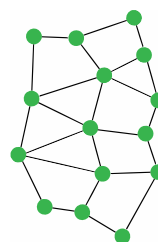
